


Tennis, Youth Programs, Pickleball, Lessons, Clinics... KVTA has it all!

Do you know the world's oldest tennis court is still in use today? The Royal Tennis Court, located at Hampton Court Palace in London, is the world's oldest tennis court and it is still in use. Built between 1526 and 1529, it was Henry VIII's preferred venue to indulge his love of tennis. Legend has it that he was given the news of Queen Anne Boleyn's execution while he was playing tennis on the court. The game played on this court was slightly different from modern tennis--the sport was called "real tennis" and played indoors. Find out more!
